“Blessing Our Graduates” Scholarship Form 2022

The Scholarship Committee has the responsibility to encourage, educate, inform and assist students in the pursuit of their educational endeavors and future careers at Rehoboth Baptist Church. The committee provides financial support to all high school graduates who provide proof to continue their post-secondary education. This scholarship is non-competitive.

Mission

The mission of the Scholarship Committee is to help individuals know and grow their relationship with Jesus Christ in order to live victorious Christian lives and share this life with others.

Blessing Our Graduates:

Blessings of \$350 per year with yearly proof of enrollment with a maximum of four years on or before age 21.

Blessings of \$150 for students who are undecided about continuing their education after high school.

Students with extenuating circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis through pastor’s approval.

- Applicant **must** be a church member, under Watchcare, or their parents **must** be a member or under Watchcare.
- Applicant **must** submit the scholarship form by **Friday, April 29, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.**
- Applicant **must** submit proof of enrollment to an accredited institution of higher learning on a yearly basis in order to receive the blessing. Proof of enrollment deadline: **July 31, 2022 in order to receive \$350.**
- Applicant **must** attend one of the following: post-secondary institutions, college/university, vocational, trade, certification, technical, accredited barber, accredited cosmetology, seminary, or conservatory.
- Applicant **must** attach a picture to application form or send one via email to scholarship@rehoboth-baptist.com for the bulletin board.

Important Note: You have the responsibility to let us know if this blessing interferes with or violates the conditions of other scholarships you have been awarded, so other arrangements can be made.
